## Bunny Gift Bags

*These adorable gift bags have always been a big hit. Get ready to share the pattern.*

### Supplies Needed:

White paper lunch bags  
White poster paper (or thin white cardboard)  
½ inch pink ribbon (12 inches per bag)  
Plastic craft whiskers  
Pink ball buttons (glass or transparent plastic)  
Permanent magic marker  
Pink watercolor paint  
Hot glue gun and clear glue  
Paint brush  
Scissors



### Directions:

1. Cut out the bunny template. The small template is used for this project.
2. Using white poster paper cut as many bunny heads as needed.
3. Using hot glue, apply center of 3 to 4 whiskers where the nose is noted on template.
4. Using hot glue, apply button nose over the center of whiskers.
5. Using permanent black marker, apply eyes and mouth as noted on template.
6. Using watercolor, mix very little paint to water and lightly "wash" on cheeks as noted on template.
7. Cut ribbon into 12 inch strips.
8. Flatten lunch bag and cut 2 small slits about 2 inches from top of bag and 2 inches apart.
9. Using hot glue, apply only the center of the bunny's head to the bottom half of white lunch bag, making sure not to glue the ears down.
10. Fill bags with goodies and insert ribbon through bag slits, making sure to insert through back slits to close. Tie bow in front of bags.

Repeat until you create as many bags as needed for your guests.

As pictured, I fill a large white basket with gift bags and tie a larger matching pink ribbon onto the basket handle and place an extra bunny in the center of the basket's bow.
