Common Uses For Baking Soda

Remove Grease from Kitchen: Mix baking soda with water into a thick paste. Use a cloth and rub in circular motions. Wipe clean.

Clean burns on bottom of pots: Sprinkle baking soda on the bottom of the pot and then let it soak in hot water overnight.

Garbage Disposal: Pour baking soda down disposal and run warm water. It keeps things fresh.

Rust on Counters: Sprinkle baking soda and scrub using 1/2 a lemon.

Dishwasher: Remove odors by sprinkling baking soda on the bottom.

Cleaning Tile: Use a mixture of baking soda and water, combine and use a reusable cloth to scrub away at the grimy grout.

Unclog Your Drain: 1/2 cup baking soda mixed with 2 cups warm vinegar. Pour down your drain to keep it clog free. Flush with hot water. Do it quarterly to keep things flowing well.

Clean Silver: Sprinkle baking soda on a damp cloth, gently polish the tarnish away.

Remove odors from your hands. Rinse your hands, keep them wet, coat hands with baking soda and scrub for 30 seconds before rinsing them clean.

Laundry: Put 1/2 a cup in the Rinse cycle to make your clothes whiter and brighter.

Carpet: Sprinkle on carpet to remove odors and pet smell.

Rain Repellent: Use a wet cloth, pour a good amount of baking soda on the cloth and then rub onto the windshield until gone.

Facial Cleanser: 1 tsp. baking soda and water to thin consistency. Rub onto face gently and wash off with water. As with any facial products do a sensitivity test first to see if it agrees with your skin type.

Litter Boxes: Baking soda sprinkled in the litter will help keep away odors longer.

Wet Pet Smell: Sprinkle Baking soda on fur and then brush out.

Lawn Furniture: Clean with 1/4 cup baking soda and 1 quart warm water.

Camping Gear: Before packing it away sprinkle in some baking powder to keep it fresh for the next use.

Smoker's House: Keep a bowl in the room or rooms where the stale smell lingers.

Smelly Shoes: Sprinkle baking soda inside the shoes to keep them smelling fresh.
